• There are several MARNING and CAUTION sections in this booklet concerning safety when installing or removing the cargo tray. Always read and follow the instructions in order to prevent injuries, accidents, and possible damage to the vehicle.

MARNING: Indicates a situation in which serious injury or death could result if

CAUTION: Indicates a situation in which bodily injury or damage to the vehicle

could result if the caution is ignored.

Do not modify the cargo liner.

- Do not install the cargo liner in any way other than described in the following instructions.
- If in doubt, please contact your Mazda dealer to install the accessory in order to prevent errors in installation.
- Your cargo liner is designed to transport normal cargo contents. Flammable or dangerous materials should not be transported in your vehicle at any time. If any corrosive chemicals are spilled on your cargo tray, it should be cleaned as described in the Care and Cleaning section.
- If you have any questions about the use of the accessory, ask your Mazda dealer for proper advice before using it.
- Mazda and its suppliers are not responsible for injuries, accidents, and damage to persons and property that arise from the failure of the dealer or installer to follow these instructions.
- To ensure safety and reliability of the work, installation, removal and disposal work must be carried out by an Authorized Mazda Dealership.
- Be careful not to lose removed parts, and be sure that they are kept free of dirt, scratches, or damage.



3. BEFORE INSTALLATION


WARNING

Before performing any work, park the vehicle on level ground, apply the parking brake securely, and then block the wheels. If the vehicle moves while performing work, it may cause injury.



Static electricity can cause an explosion of flammable liquid, vapor or gas in any vehicle or trailer. To reduce risk of serious injury when filling containers:

- -Always place container on the ground before filling.
- -Keep the nozzle in contact with the container while you are filling it.
- -Use only approved containers for flammable liquid.






∕!\ CARE & CLEANING

- This product protects your vehicle from being soiled, damaged, or getting wet by small amounts of water. However, the product itself may be soiled or damaged, or get wet.
- When cleaning the cargo liner, use warm water or diluted mild detergent.
- Never use any organic solvent such as thinner or benzene.
- Rinse cargo liner thoroughly with water and allow it to dry before reinstalling.
- · When not using the cargo liner, wash the liner with water and dry it completely before storing it on a flat surface. To prevent deformation when storing, do not place any heavy object on top of the liner.

4. CARGO LINER INSTALLATION


- Cargo area should be dry and clear of debris before attempting installation.



1. Press the push knob to fold down the seatback.



- 2. Place the seat back liner on the back of the rear seat.
- 3. Align child seat anchor symbol at the top of the child seat anchor window(s) found in the seat back cargo liner.



- 4. Remove white protective backing from adapter hook and loop pads and fix cargo liner in position.
- 5. Repeat for other side.

Note: Make sure the placement of the seat back liner does not interfere with the cargo board when returning the rear seat to its upright position.



- 6. Place the cargo liner in the cargo area as shown.
- 7. Align cargo liner hinge with the cargo floor hinge.
- 8. Remove white protective backing from adapter hook and loop pads and fix cargo liner in position.
- 9. Return the rear seats to their upright position.
